\_St. Peter's History Did you know?



The parish collections for the (new) church construction continued for a number of years after the laying of St. Peter's corner stone. In 1906, the sum of \$20.28 was collected and in 1907 the congregation collected a further \$27.48. On Tuesday, November 16, 1909, the Rt. Reverend Llewellyn Jones consecrated our beautiful St. Peter's.
