St. Peter's History Did you know?

St. Peter's congregation has produced two priests (in earlier years) for the larger Christian community. **The Rev'd Samuel J. Andrews** was born at Upper Gullies and trained at Queens College. His parents were Henry and Susannah LeDrew-Andrews. He served in the White Bay Mission from 1883-1894 and then moved to the United States.

The Rev'd Edward Andrews was born to Charles and Sarah Andrews of Upper Gullies on November 19, 1879. He received his Masters degree from St. Augustine s College, Canterbury, England. At the time of his death, he was Rector of St. Mary's Church, Haughteen Green, Manchester, England. The Choir Stalls at St. Peter's were placed there in his memory by his sister, Naomi Haines.
