Did you know?**

**Baptismal Font- A long History**



St. Peter’s Baptismal Font has an interesting history. While the Font was being moved to replace carpet in January, 1995, an inscription was discovered. It was etched into the base pedestal of the Font and reads: “Executed and presented by Austin Jarvis, born in Martin, in this Parish-1794.” This tells us that the Font is now 223 years old. Hopewell had received it from the Rev. Canon Brown at the Cathedral in 1898.
