# **Today's Short Message**

For many years I was unable to respond to the call to ordained ministry because I did not believe many of the doctrines and teachings of the church. I was something like Thomas who said, "Unless I... put my finger in the marks of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe." (John 20:25)

Eventually, I surrendered. It was not because my beliefs had changed. But I had changed. I came to realize that there is really no objective proof for God. The only assurance we can have comes from within ourselves.

Today's gospel is for people like me. John wanted to put his finger in the marks of the nails, but he never did. Instead he surrendered to the wonder

and mystery of the resurrection and worshipped. "My Lord and my God!" (20:28)

That was Thomas' moment of surrender. At such a moment doubts do not disappear. Instead faith and trust take over. Worship which helps one connect with God and receive God's grace begins.

This is the blessing that I received. I thank God for the gift of language which enables me share it with others and be affirmed by their witness of similar experiences. God's plan is wonderful and awesome. I count it a privilege to be a part of it. I pray for the grace to live up to the responsibilities God expects of me.
