Dessert & A Show

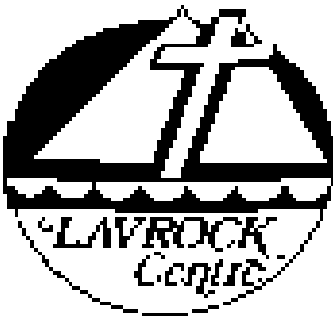
