Today's Short Message

Our National Anthem has an interesting history. The process it has gone through in the years since it was first penned by Robert Stanley Weir, a Quebec judge, in 1908 is itself a tribute to our ability as a nation to deal peaceably with the issues that arise over time. Weir wrote the lyrics for **O Canada** in 1908 in time for the 300th anniversary of the founding of Quebec City.

The French version of our National Anthem is quite different from the English. It was commissioned in 1880 for the *Congrès national des Canadiens-Français* held in Quebec City on June 24th of that year. It was written by Sir Adolphe Basile Routhier. The melody for both editions of the Anthem was composed by Calixa Lavallée.

We can compare the two versions of our National Anthem in *Common Praise*. With very little knowledge of French we can see that they are very different but are sung to the same tune. Like the two versions of the Anthem, English and French have co-existed in Canada for over 500 years. We don't always see eye to eye, but we can sing together. We are not a perfect nation, but we are the envy of many nations. As we celebrate Canada Day this year, let us pray that we will continue to "sing the same tune", not only as English and French, but with appreciation for the language, customs, cultures, faiths and common humanity of many nations.



Holy Baptism It is the practice at St. Peter's to set the date for next Baptism (no more than once a month at the 10:30 service) when the first family requiring Baptism contacts the minister.
