Today's Short Message

Before reading any further, please read the hymn #580 - *In Bethlehem a Newborn Boy*. Then read ahead and you will recognize how the author's life experience is reflected in this hymn. The *Psalms*, too, come out of real life experiences of people who lived thousands of years ago. When we realize this, hopefully they become more meaningful for us.

In Bethlehem a Newborn Boy was written by Rosamond Eleanor Herklots (1905-1987), who was born in North India to a gifted missionary family. She was educated in England and taught briefly in Palestine around 1930. She then became a secretary and spent many years as secretary to a distinguished specialist in Spina Bifida and working at the head office of the Association for Spina Bifida and Hydrocephalus. During the air-raids from 1939-45 she helped to entertain the children among the Londoners sheltering in underground stations.

Herklots began writing hymns around 1940. "She sang contralto with the Alexandria Choir which often performed at the Royal Albert Hall, and was noted for her amazing memory and 'gentle, oldfashioned humour'." Only five of her more than 60 hymns are published. "Forgive Our Sins as We Forgive" and "In Bethlehem a Newborn Boy" are found in our *Common Praise*. (Source: www.praise.org.uk)
