Today's Short Message

According to some accounts the practice of celebrating Father's Day originated with Sonora Smart Dodd who got the idea while listening to a Mother's Day sermon in 1910. Her father was a veteran of the Civil War. She wanted to honour her father who raised six children on his own after his wife died giving birth to their sixth child. Another story says that Father's Day began when Grace Golden Clayton suggested to her minister that they should have a special service to honour the fathers killed in a coal mine disaster in West Virginia in 1907.

The important human value of honouring our parents, though, go back much farther. It is a universal principle enshrined in the Ten Commandments. **"Honour your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving you."** (Exodus 20:12)

As we celebrate fatherhood today, it's important to remember that not all people have had or has good relationships with their father. The church, too, has often made the mistake of taking principles like those enshrined in the Ten Commandments as perfect and buried its head in the sand refusing to see that even good things cast a shadow. That is why someone like Jesus is necessary - to help us see our blind spots and as far as possible correct them. As a corollary to the fifth commandment we hear Jesus say **"Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs."** (Luke 18:6)

As we celebrate Father's Day, let us remember that everyone has a father. Being a father (or mother) is a big responsibility as well as a great honour. By recognizing the challenges of parenting and the difficulty of being as good as we would like to be, let us see the child of God in every father. Happy Father's Day!
