**LECTIONARY FOR TODAY: Revelation 21: 1-6; Psalm 24: 1-6, Colossians 1: 9-14, John 11: 32-44.**

**COLLECT:** Almighty God, whose people are knit together in one holy Church, the mystical Body of your Son, grant us grace to follow your blessed saints in lives of faith and commitment, and to know the inexpressible joys you have prepared for those who love you; through your Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

***Lift our prayers for our Synod:*** O Lord God, our heavenly Father, we humbly beseech you to look with favour upon the Bishop, clergy, and laity who take counsel together at our Diocesan Synod. Bestow upon them a creative spirit; Open their hearts to recognize your presence among them; Open their minds to respond to your calling. Enable them to draw upon the wisdom and experience of yesterday as they respond to the questions and concerns of tomorrow. Give them freedom to speak the truth boldly and with kindness; Give them patience to listen openly and without prejudice; Give them confidence to discover and explore new possibilities; Give them wisdom to discern what is right and good and just; Give them courage to participate in your ongoing work of creation. Mercifully grant that the Holy Spirit may rest upon them, to enlighten and guide them; and all their consultations may be prospered to the advancement of your glory and the welfare of your Church; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Receive all we offer you this day, and help us, like them, to run our course with faith, that we may come to your eternal kingdom. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.
