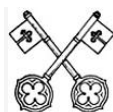

Did You Know?

The land on which St. Peter's Church now stands was originally United Church property. The old Methodist Church was removed and St. Peter's Anglican Church was built in 1905. The Church was built mostly by free labour with building materials being cut on the Salmonier Line and hauled to the site by horse. The Rector of the Foxtrap-Hopewill Mission, at that time was Canon Edward Colley.
