LECTIONARY FOR THIS WEEK, – THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER ACTS

9:1-6 (7-20); PSALM 30; REVELATION 5:11-14; JOHN 21:1-19

COLLECT: O God, your Son made himself known to his disciples in the breaking of bread. Open the eyes of our faith, that we may see him in his redeeming work, who is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

PRAYER OVER THE GIFTS: Creator of all, you wash away our sins in water, you give us new birth by the Spirit, and redeem us in the blood of Christ. As we celebrate the resurrection, renew your gift of life within us. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ the risen Lord.

PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION: Author of life divine, in the breaking of bread we know the risen Lord. Feed us always in these mysteries, that we may show your glory to all the world. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.
