# Did you know? From the archives of St. Peter's

At the annual meeting of St. Peter's congregation in 1899 there was a discussion about the need for a new church building and as a result a committee was formed to start a fund for that purpose. They were asked to make a collection that year. There was another collection made in 1900 and although there was no further mention of it, the collections were most likely made on a yearly basis until the church was completed.

The records show that clergy also had their problems back at the turn of the century. At the Annual meeting of 1900 the problem on maintaining the cemetery fence arose and it was decided that any member of the congregation who did not bring stakes or rails would have to pay \$1.00 to open a grave. At the meeting the following year the Rev. Petley reminded the congregation of "their unfulfilled promises to provide hay for his horse – but no steps were taken to mend the matter." Hopefully there was enough hay to feed the horse that winter.
