Covid 19 is still with us, however our church is open for Church each Sunday at 10:30 am and it's good to see many of our parishioners attend this service. We are getting close to our maximum capacity for Department of health rules. therefore it's very important if you are planning to attend a service to register not later than 12:00 noon on Friday previous to the service. The new Audio-Visual equipment is now installed in our Church so services are available to those who which to watch from home on FB live and YouTube. We continue to receive good monetary support from Church Services and other options are available to give if you wish. At a recent vestry meeting, discussion took place in respect to the possibility of having fundraising activities this fall.
