#### Message from Our Treasurer

#### Parishioner and Friends of St. Peter's,

We have just come to the end of 5 months into 2021. Five more months of living with COOVID 19, however, thanks to the Lord, it seems that more and more people are being vaccinated so COVID is finally heading in the right direction. As your treasurer, I stated some time ago, to keep you informed of our finances and other items of interest as it relates to your church. \

At the end of May, with our assessment paid up to date and the Church Insurance of some \$5,500 paid, we show a chequing account balance of approximately \$20,000. This does not include \$22,000 in the cemetery fund or the \$7,000 in the building fund. We are down slightly from projected budget, however I am so thankful to everyone who are keeping up their contributions to their Church in these difficult times. We will be sending a special letter of appeal in June, as we did last year to help make up for lost revenue as it relates to our fundraising projects.

#### Other Items of interest

On May 30, the AGM was held in the Parish Hall where approximately 30 persons attended. The annual reports for the year 2019 & 2020 were presented and the reports from all church organizations and accompanying financial statements were discussed. All reports and statements were approved by all present. Those present took copies of the reports and others wishing to do so, can pick up a copy at the Church office.

The election of officers to the Vestry, Synod Delegates and Warden's took place. We thank those who have finished their term and we welcome the people who were successful in filling the offices mentioned. It is nice to see new faces filling these rolls at St. Peter's.
