

Removal/Moving of Flowers from Graves

The cemetery committee will commence mowing again this week and is asking that flowers be removed from the center of graves to permit this work. They are encouraging parishioners that if they do not wish to remove their flowers, to place them next to the headstone (on either side), or better yet avail of a 'saddle type' arrangement that fits securely on top of the monument. Single stem artificial flowers can cause injury (this has happened in the past), if inadvertently ran over by the cemetery's lawn mower, so please make sure that all such arrangements be placed in a position as not to interfere with mowing. Flowers that interfere with mowing and maintenance will be removed and discarded by the cemetery committee. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding in this matter.
