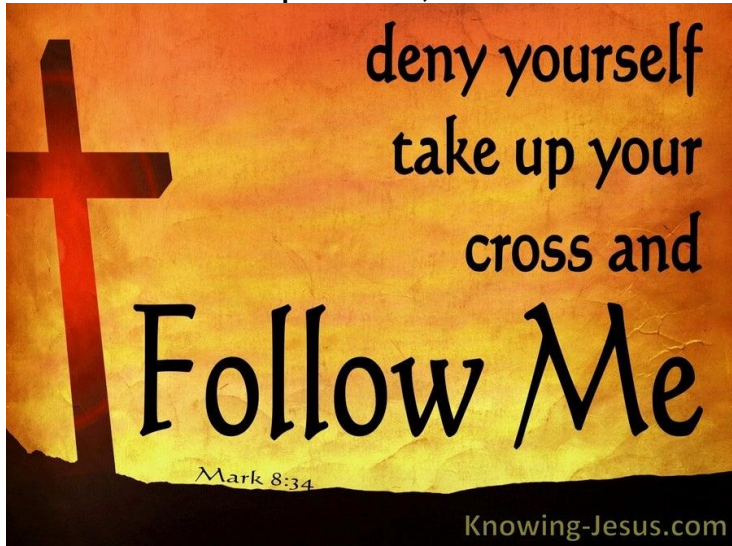

After thirteen years of commitment to providing wool/yarn and the knitting of the Izzy Dolls, it has been brought to my attention by Mr. John Metcalfe (retired Peacekeeper and the original spokesperson for this project) that due to the Covid 19 Pandemic worldwide, it is now impossible for shipping and the maintaining of a distributor for the dolls.

If there are knitters who still have dolls at home, please call me and I will pick them up or you can deliver them to me personally. Mr. Metcalfe will continue to receive the already knitted dolls, however; that will be the end of the Izzy Dolls at St. Peter's. On behalf of Mr. Metcalfe and myself, we want to thank everyone who helped with this successful endeavor.

We have sent approximately 35,000 Izzy Dolls to the third world countries during this 13-year period. Your acts of kindness have left an everlasting impact on so many underprivileged children living in poverty.

A huge thank you to all who volunteered their talents in knitting the dolls and to those who donated the yarn/wool.
